

Curricular Development (750 words): Applications should demonstrate a commitment to the development and implementation of at least one core text, liberal arts course in the institution's curriculum. The directors are interested in the potential impact of piloted course(s) on development, extension, enrichment, or revision of programs of institutions.

8. Certification:

The signing official certifies an institution's willingness to provide support (as specified under "Stipends and Obligations" above) for the attendance of a two-member team or one individual at the "Rejuvenating and Reinventing" summer seminar. The official also certifies support for development and implementation of at least one new or substantially revised core text course, using texts from the trivium, for inclusion in the undergraduate curriculum. Development is to commence in the fall following the "Rejuvenating and Reinventing" seminar with pilot implementation in the second term of the 2019-2020 academic year. It is understood that these courses will be ultimately subject to the approval of the appropriate institutional authorities. The signing official also agrees to provide support for two meetings with a faculty group at the participating institution (a) to report on the summer seminar and (b) to report in early 2020 on the development and imminent implementation of any pilot core text course(s). The signing official also agrees to transmit a report, written by "Reinventing and Rejuvenating" team participants, to the project directors by April 1, 2020.
